The Takla Lake Band Councillor Election (to elect 2 Councillors) will be held on the following dates:
Wed. May 17 (PG) Thurs. May 18 (Ft.St.James) and Fri. May 19th (Takla)

(Note: Chief John French and Councillors Sandra Teegee and Chris French's term ends in 2019)

Steps to Nominate Candidates:

For In-Person Nominations:

The **Nomination Meeting will be on Fri. Apr. 7th from 6-8pm in the Bahlats Hall**, Takla Landing. Please note for those who choose to make a nomination in-person at the nomination meeting, they may do so.

For Mail-In Nominations:

Off-reserve members can nominate candidates, using the attached 'Mail-in Nomination Form' and mail it back to:

Electoral Officer, PO Box 4324, Williams Lake, BC V2G 2V4

Please note: each elector may not nominate more than 2 people

Also, please do not forget to sign 'Mail-in Nomination Form' and get someone else (any other adult) to witness it and sign it as well.

Following the nomination meeting, the Electoral Officer will send out a notice of the election and ballots so you may vote by mail.

Please note that all **mail-in nominations** must be received before the end of the nomination meeting (on April 7th at 8:00 pm)

For Election Candidates:

Before the end of the nomination meeting, candidates must pay their refundable deposit fee of \$100, and sign a declaration allowing the Band to recover any debts to the Band, they must commit to getting a Criminal Record Check and to not abuse drugs or alcohol. Candidates can sign these forms before the meeting, but the Electoral Officer **MUST** receive forms and the \$100 fee before the end of the meeting.
